Over the years **EG KIGHT** has emerged as a preeminent voice in roots music. And *CityBeat Cincinnati* writes that Kight is "a cross between Bonnie Raitt's bourbon stung growl and Phoebe Snow's emotive warble."

In her 25+ years in the blues Kight has entertained on stages around the world, and has received 19 various music industry nominations, including nine for *Female Artist of the Year*, three for *Song of the Year*, and four for *Album of the Year*, which includes a nod for her 2021 release, *THE TRIO SESSIONS*. And her 2023 release, *STICKS & STRINGS*, was nominated for Acoustic Album of the Year.



And *STICKS & STRINGS*, which again features the trio, also debuted in the #10 spot on the Billboard Blues Chart, at #11 on the Big Blues Chart, #16 on the Living Blues Radio Chart, at #22 on the NACC chart, and at #19 on the Australian Blues and Roots Radio Chart.
